

Choir Boosters Meeting  
February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2004

Meeting was opened by Theresa Dalen, President, at 6:35pm.

Secretary's report was presented by Cynthia Overson. All were in favor of accepting the January meeting minutes. Motion passed.

Tina Brown presented her Treasurer's Report. We looked at income and expense categories, discussed delinquent accounts, and talked about monies yet to be recorded. It was decided that Aaron Olson would contact fans and guests that have not yet paid for Nashville, and Nancy Parris will be given the names of students to contact who have not yet paid for the Nashville trip. To date, we are only missing \$100 of regular student fees. Tina said she still needs to touch base with Nancy Parris on her budget paperwork, whether she has transferred everything over correctly, and for clarification on a few issues. It was also discussed that the finance committee needs to meet again. Craig Stanton said that he and Keith Peters would like to be on the finance committee, but just needed to be informed of dates and times for meetings. Motion was made by Cynthia Overson to accept Treasurer's report, and seconded by Susan Morimoto. Motion passed.

Spectacular update: We opened with a discussion of the cost of the ad in the Patriot. Aaron Olson will take care of this with Chuck Larsen, and make sure that the cost stays at what was budgeted. Ticket costs have been set at \$7 and \$4 (last year we charged \$6 and \$3). Susan Morimoto noted that we are charged \$6 for sporting events, so this seems to be a reasonable fee structure we have set for our event.

Banquet update: Linda Stanton has printed invitations and will mail them soon, in order to get responses and monies before the Nashville trip. Cost will be the same as last year because the fees at Island View have not changed. Linda requested a list of senior names so that she could begin acquiring senior gifts. Barbara Bostic is arranging for decorations. She will be using the decorations from the Spectacular.

Aaron Olson introduced the possibility of hosting a show choir competition at our school next year on January 29<sup>th</sup>. Craig Stanton asked what Aaron's main motivation was, and Aaron said that it was money. Discussion was held on the merits of holding such an event, costs and possible revenues associated with the event, if school administration favored doing such an event, and if we need to have approval from the school board. The choir booster board requested that Aaron get more concrete numbers for costs, and do some research with other schools on details of hosting such an event. We will vote on this at a later date.

Motion to adjourn was made by Barbara Bostic, and seconded by Craig Stanton. Motion passed.
